Job Description

CERP is seeking a proactive self-starter who is a quick learner, willing to take on new challenges and loves working with data to fill the role of the Business Development Associate. Under the supervision of the Analytics Manager, the Business Development Associate will support pilot engagements and will manage stakeholder relations for new partners. This primarily entails relationship management and business development activities, including:

- Support business development efforts
 - a. Identify and develop new business with both existing clients as well as new prospects
 - b. Engage in client visits, especially on-ground engagement with the current partners on all established activities and new engagements
 - c. Assist in developing content for marketing pieces such as flyers and web pages, particularly through provision of information about new courses
 - d. Participate in promotional and outreach events such as research forums and introductory sessions
- Actively collaborates with peers across teams and geographies to share knowledge, support quality
 execution, contribute to design and solve problems working to develop capabilities across the
 development community, especially with partner organisations
